COVID-19: Alert Level 2 Reminders

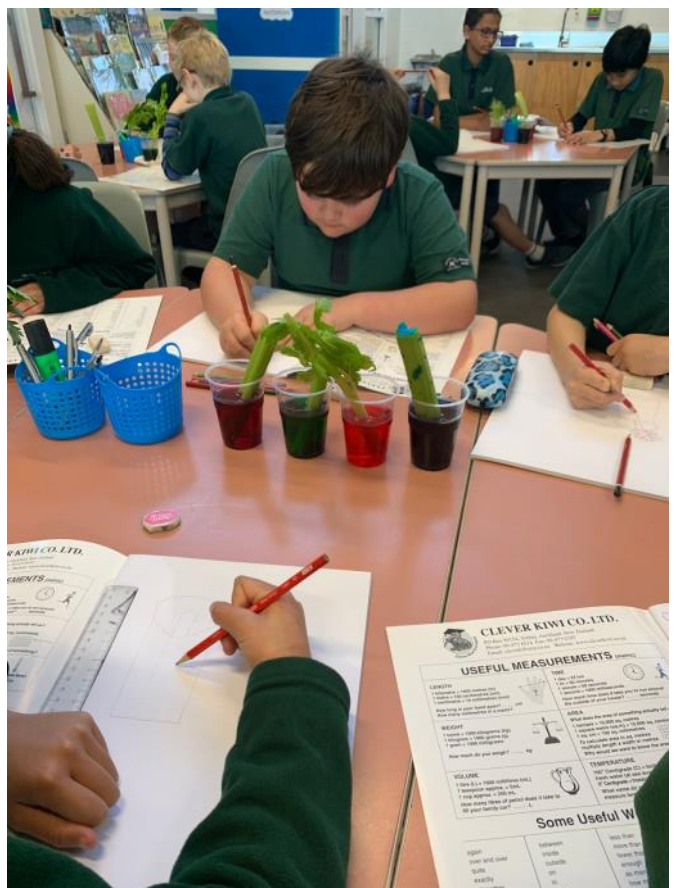
This means we are now in a position where we have room to accommodate more new entrants—both in zone and we also have **available 10 out of zone places for Term 4 of this year.**
